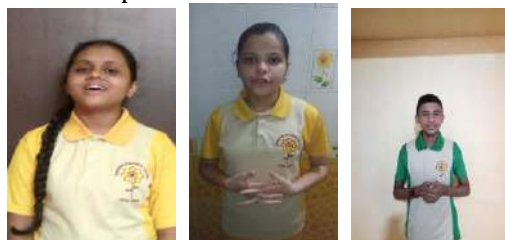
RAKSHABANDHAN

GANESH CHATURTHI



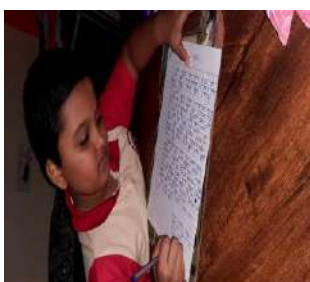

NATIONAL SPORTS DAY

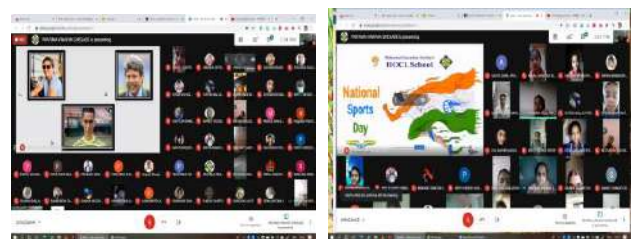

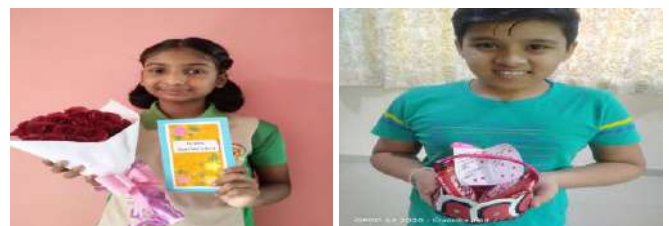
TEACHERS DAY CELEBRATION

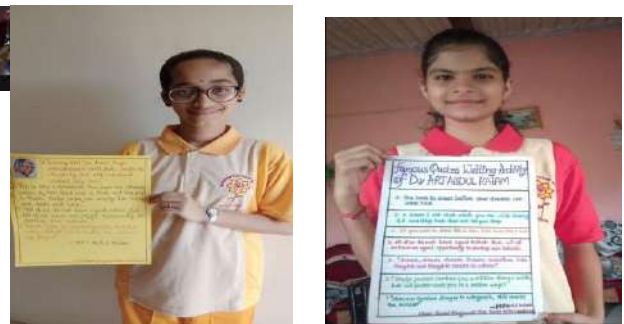
GLOBAL HAND WASHING DAY
