A Glass Painting Competition was conducted for the students of **Class XI** to draw, design, and focus on the ability to visualise ideas three dimensionally.



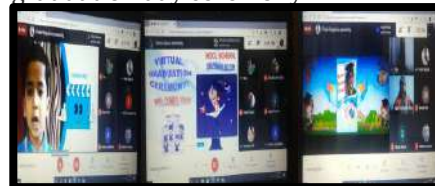
MAKAR SANKRANTI
