Anti-Bullying Committee**

An Anti-Bullying Committee is a dedicated group within a school or educational institution focused on preventing, addressing, and resolving instances of bullying. This committee works to create a safe and inclusive environment by implementing strategies to reduce and eliminate bullying behaviors among students.

According to the CBSE circular no.: Acad.-17/2015 (CBSE/Acad/Dir(Arti)/2015) dated 9th March 2015, bullying can be directly from the bully to the victim(e.g., through physical intimidation or attacks, verbal abuse, unwanted attention and advances, damaging property), or it can be indirect (e.g., through spreading malicious rumors). It can also include cyber-bullying (e.g., sending unpleasant messages, photographs and emails, to the victim or to others).

The committee's goals include:

- Raising awareness: Informing students and parents about bullying, its causes, consequences, and unacceptability
- Devising measures: Creating school-based ways to prevent and deal with bullying
- Fostering partnerships: Working with parents to maintain a bully-free environment
- Educating: Providing life skills, value education, and human rights education
